Make reading a part of your child's daily routine

Every day your child will take part in **E.R.I.C Time** (Every Child Reading In Class). We will be having fun sharing and reading books at 11.50pm & 3pm each day.

On a <u>Friday</u> your child can also bring in a favourite book from home to share with the class during E.R.I.C Time.

Nursery Reminders



Please regularly re-label all clothes including coats, jumpers, hats & scarves. As some items of clothing, can become muddled, please can you check your child's clothes at home and send in any items that don't belong to you.



We ask that all children bring P.E pumps to Nursery.

P.E pumps are to be sent in on your child's first day at Nursery. We will send them home when they no longer fit and your child needs new pumps.
