Snack & Lunchtime



- Afternoon Snack & Water Bottle (sippy lid)
- At lunch time, all Reception children sit together in the dinner Hall. Our Mid-Day Supervisors look after the Reception children at Lunch Time. They will inform us if your child has not eaten their lunch. You will then be informed at home time that day.

Otherwise, your child is having a happy lunch.

Do not worry if your child does not eat all of their lunch initially. As they learn our lunchtime routines and grow in confidence you will find that they will eat more ©





Getting Ready for Starting School

We encourage the children to become independent from when they first start school. Here are some key skills which will help them as they start school:

- Can they go to the toilet independently; washing & drying their hands?
- Can they put their coat on and off and zip it up?
- Can they take their shoes/wellies on and off?
- Can they take their jumper/cardigan on and off?
- Can they use and knife, fork and spoon?
- Can they recognise their name?
- Are they happy to play with their new friends and share toys?
- Can they sit and listen to a story?
- Can they sit and do a simple jigsaw or craft for 5 minutes?

P.E Kit – Green St Bernadette's t-shirt, black joggers and a black hoodie & black trainers.



- Class Dojo is an online classroom community which enables Teachers and Parents to connect.
- Each child is assigned a Dojo Monster and will receive Dojo rewards.
- We use Class Dojo to share exciting events in Reception, to communicate to Parents and to set activities.
- You will receive an invite to join when your child starts school.



There are times that your child will need First Aid....

- Within School we have a number of staff who have completed their Full First Ad training and the Reception staff have completed their Paediatric First Aid Training.
- ♦ Major & Complex needs Need to complete a Health Care Plan.
- Allergies Please inform us of any allergy (even if not likely to be in contact with allergen in Reception)
- ♦ Anthisan Send in a letter if you do not wish us to use this.
- ♦ Inhalers Must send one in to be kept in class.
- Sun cream applied before school & children will only be allowed out if wearing a sunhat.
- Medicines Complete a request Form
- Rashes We will ask you to get these confirmed by a Doctor or Nurse.
- ♦ Sickness Must be kept off for 48 hours from the last episode.
- ◇ Accidents Bump letter MAJOR BUMPS You will be informed.
- ◊ Nit Night!!!!
