

Parent/Carer Survey


Thank you to everyone who filled in our recent parent/carer survey around the Catholic life and mission of the school, religious education and collective worship. We would like to share the positive outcomes:


7. I understand the school's Catholic mission of 'Growing Together in Faith, Love and Learning' and I am supportive of it.




As a school we grow from the feedback we receive and strive to make any improvements that will continue to extend the children's experience and learning in school. Below are the actions we have taken on feedback.

Religious Education

As part of the RE curriculum, we study different world religions. This helps pupils to develop an understanding of themselves and others, promoting their spiritual, moral, social and cultural development. Through the survey results, there was also a little uncertainty and misunderstanding around the split of other faiths taught and our Catholic teachings.

During each autumn term, children are taught a unit on Judaism. The children learn about how their Jewish brothers and sisters live and what they believe as the theme develops. Hinduism, Islam and Sikhism are taught on a three year cycle in the summer term.
